We are currently seeking \$400,000.

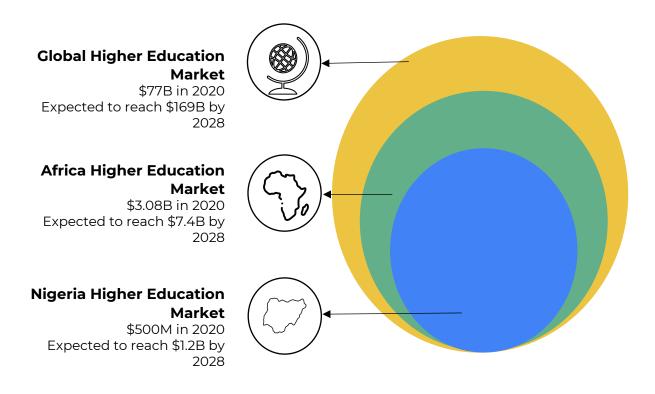

Market and Industry Analysis – The Higher Education Space

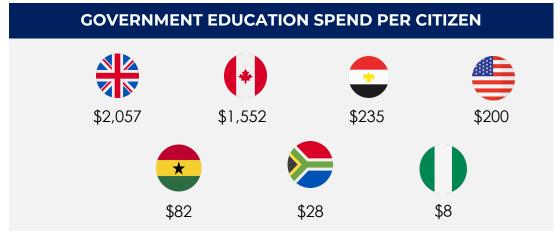


In 2020, the global contribution to Higher Education stood at \$13.7T. This number grew by 2% in 2021. Africa makes up 12% of the 220 million global student population. In the African market, Nigeria makes up 14% of the tertiary education space

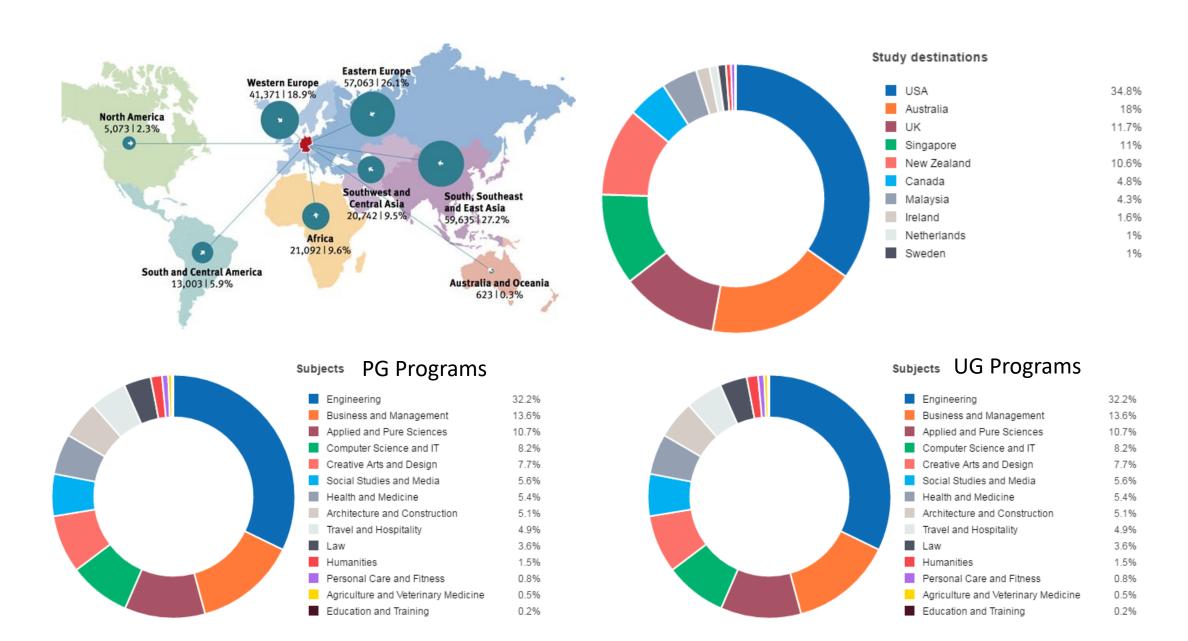
